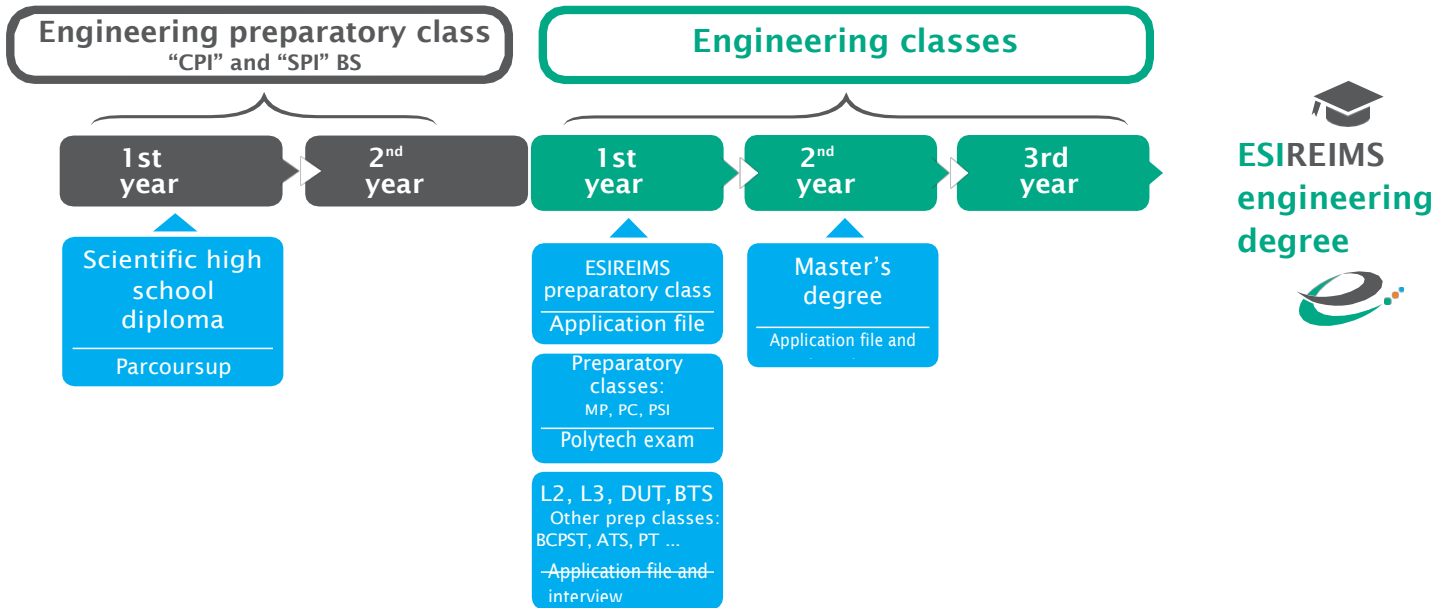


2 ways to be admitted

· YOU ARE ABOUT TO GET YOUR HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA:

You have to apply on Parcoursup website to get into ESIREIMS Engineering preparatory class. The recommended majors are: Maths, Physics/Chemistry, Engineering Sciences, or Biology.

· YOU ARE ABOUT TO GET A 2-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE:

You have to send an application file and you will be interviewed to get into ESIREIMS Engineering classes.

BS: Any Bachelor's degree in Science.

Technology degree:

- **Packaging engineering:** Physical measurements, Packaging, Mechanical and Production engineering, Chemistry engineering, Biology engineering...
- **Energy engineering:** Thermal and Energy engineering, Materials and Science engineering, Civil engineering, Mechanical and Production engineering...
- **Environmental and Urban Planning engineering:** Sustainable building Civil engineering, Energy and Thermal engineering, Physical measurements, Materials and Science engineering, Biology engineering, Networks and Telecommunications...

· YOU ARE IN A PREPARATORY CLASS:

In MP, PC, PSI classes: Polytech competitive exam - You have to apply on www.scei-concours.fr

Other preparatory classes (BCPST, PT, ATS...): You have to send an application file and you will be interviewed to get into ESIREIMS Engineering classes. You have to be eligible for an engineering school, or have 120 ECTS at least.

· YOU ARE ABOUT TO GET A MASTER'S DEGREE (OR EQUIVALENT):

You have to send an application file and you will be interviewed to get into ESIREIMS Engineering classes.



ANNUAL TUITION

ESIREIMS is a French public engineering school. fees are those of the University of Reims Champagne-Ardennes, and they are set each year by the Ministry of Higher Education, Research and Innovation.

- Have a scientific and technical university degree.
- Have a B2 level in French (Common European Framework of References for Languages)

· CANDIDATES OUTSIDE THE EUROPEAN UNION:

Students from countries having the "Études en France" program

You have to apply for the 'Études en France' (ex-Campus France) program.

It is compulsory to get through this program application to be accepted to ESIREIMS.

You have to send your application:
