



The imposing Sainte-Clotilde Basilica, which is Neo-Byzantine in style, has a crypt containing relics from some 2,000 French saints










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# FOUJITA CHAPEL

After his conversion to Catholicism, the French-Japanes painter Leonard Foujita designed this Neo-Romanesque chapel in 1966. The iconographical programme of the stainedglass windows and of the 200 m<sup>2</sup> large fresco is inspired by e Christ's life, but also partly by the Japanese tradition.


