1ST EDITION OF «BAZANCOURT POMACLE, THE ATTRACTIVE INDUSTRY»

Within the framework of the French Industry Week, the CMQ organised the 1st edition of « Bazancourt Pomacle, the Attractive Industry » with the collaboration of its partners: the CEBB, Cristal Union, ARD, Givaudan, FICA HPCI and the Grand Est region.

About 400 students and job seekers were welcomed at the CEBB to discover and exchange with the industries of the Bazancourt Pomacle biorefinery.

The first day took place on December 2nd with highschool students from Georges Brière (Reims), Libergier (Reims), Les Lombards (Troyes), Hessel (Épernay), Verlaine (Rethel) and Sévigné (Charleville). They were able to go from stand to stand on an « information hunt » and talk to professionals from the Bazancourt-Pomacle site about the training courses and jobs needed in their companies. A bus tour of the biorefinery was also available.

On December 6th, the second day took place where students from BUT, Masters and job seekers were attended with a programme including company visits, training/advice stands and the UIMM's « Magical Industry Tour ».

TEAM WORK : CMQ AND DREDI URCA AT SALON DES ÉTUDES EN FRANCE

Last November, the CMQ d'Excellence Bioeco Academy took part with the URCA's Direction des Relations Extérieures et du Développement International (DREDI) in the 2022 edition of the Salon des études en France organised by the French Embassy in Belgium and Campus France Belgique.

With the participation of more than 50 French educational institutions gathered in Brussels, the CMQ was delighted to introduce the Belgian public to the training courses associated to bioeconomy offered by the URCA.

THE AGRI-VITI LABOUR MARKET IN FOCUS

The CMQ was invited on December 7th, by the MSA Marne Ardennes Meuse, to present the evolution of employment in the agri-economy with a particular focus on recruitment difficulties, staff turnover and solutions to retain staff.

This conference focused on the global presentation of the bioeconomy, the key figures in agriculture and industry and the recommendations, followed by a time of

exchange around the problems encountered in the field. The result was a clear emphasis on the importance of guidance and training professionals being able to respond to part of the problem.



BIOECONOMY EDUCATION: A EUROPEAN PRIORITY

The CMQ went to Prague to participate in the conference « Bioeconomy Education: a Bioeast Perspective ».

During the conference, an important question was asked : Why do we need bioeconomy education?

The answer can be found by analysing the current international situation. Education for sustainable development is needed and we are already in this european approach, ready to support and collaborate with our neighbouring countries.

The importance of vocational training was also mentioned during the panel discussion, as well as the situation of the BioEast project at the macro regional level.



BIOECONOMY ORIENTATION MORNINGS

What is a bio-based product? What are the research challenges for developing the bioeconomy? What are the training courses and other jobs in this sector? These were the questions raised during the discussions with the 70 students of the Sacré Coeur High School in Reims at the CEBB. The students were also able to visit the CEBB laboratories, test the new version of the biomass game « made in CEBB », discover the exhibition of biobased objects and the bioeconomy memory.

This project was funded under the Call for Collaborative Projects proposed by the CMQ d'Excellence Bioeco Academy.


