Basic information about characteristics of University

The region Champagne–Ardenne, worldwide – famous for its vineyards and its champagne, has a privileged position in the heart of the Europe at the crossing of Germany, Belgium and Luxemburg. Reims, a dynamic university town with 185 000 inhabitants, is the largest city in the region and twelfth largest one in France by population. Just 45 minutes away from Paris by train, it is famous for its history with several sites listed on UNESCO’s list of world cultural in heritage.

A multi – disciplinary university, The URCA (Université de Reims Champagne – Ardenne) has 5 study fields:
