The CMQ had the pleasure of accompanying the students of the Master's degree in Applied Economics (Specialization : studies for sustainable development and ecological transition - CEDDETE) on their visit to the Agricyclage, a recent site specialized in the management and recovery of bio-waste at Sorbon in the Ardennes region.

During the morning session, the 3 stages of waste treatment, its nature and origin were presented. Discussions touched on many aspects of this local solution for agricultural anaerobic digestion and the links that exist with urban life, in this case the production of biogas for 9600 habitants.

It was a fascinating meeting, full of hope for the future of our regions.

As part of the "Ropes of Success" program, a one-day Careers Forum was organized at Signy-l'Abbaye secondary school for all 5th, 4th and 3rd year students.

Dozens of professionals from various backgrounds came to present the opportunities in their sector of activity.



The opportunity to present our new activity: My Green Career, a collaborative board game designed to help students discover the 30 future careers in industrial biotechnologies identified by the MéFoBio study. A total of 150 students were introduced to bioeconomy.

A first step into the world of research for these students from different disciplines, with 3 students from the Master's degree program in Biotechnologies and Agroressources Engineering (CMI BA) and 11 from the Master's degree program in Applied Economics (CEDDETE).

#### MÉFOBIO: PRESENTATION AND JOB DESCRIPTIONS

5 months after the signing of the Region's industrial biotechnology and plant-based chemistry contract at the Foire de Châlons, the 1st steering committee meeting was held at the Lorraine Incubator in Vandœuvre-lès-Nancy.

The occasion was used to present the background to the MéFoBio study (dealing with the trades, training and skills of the future in industrial biotechnologies in the Grand Est conducted from September 2022 to March 2023), and its main results:

- 38 strategic professions divided into 6 families
- 17 strategic skills divided into 7 families
- 193 training courses fromProfessionalisation certificates to PhD
